



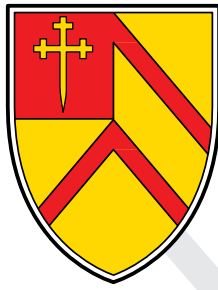

The Vision of Mobberley Cricket Club

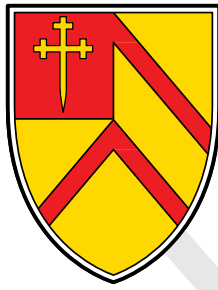
